

## **Students**

### **Student Activities – Fund Raising**

The School Board recognizes that participation of students under faculty supervision in the process of planning and obtaining financial support for their own activities may be desirable as part of the educational process.

Student fund raising shall be on a school-wide basis insofar as possible and competitive activities as between students or groups of students shall be avoided. Incentives for individuals or groups may be used at the discretion of the Building Principal.

Funds raised through student efforts shall be subject to the control of the Building Principal with the advice and consent of the sponsors. The use of such funds shall be employed to the maximum extent possible for student activities.

The use of students to promote fund raising activities of parents' groups or any other fund raising activities shall generally be discouraged except in the case of activities pre-approved by the Building Principal and which are of a school-wide nature in which participation can be a positive experience for students and when the proceeds contribute to a recognized humanitarian purpose.

### **Student Activities – Student Solicitations**

Students, staff members or the facilities of the school may not be used in any manner for solicitations or promoting the interests of any agency or organization or person with the approval of the School Board with the following exceptions.

1. The Superintendent may cooperate in furthering the work of any nonprofit, community-wide, i.e., Pumpkin Festival, agency provided such cooperation does not infringe on the school program or diminish the amount of time devoted to the school program.
2. The Superintendent may authorize the use of films and materials which simply bear the name of the producing company, but which do not in any way involve a program or the presence of any agent in the classroom.
3. Solicitation of students on school premises involving sales of any kind for a cash payment or donation shall be done only through an approved student or parent organization. Such solicitation must be approved by the Building Principal.
4. Sales to students directly related to the educational program or extracurricular activities of the schools may be permitted upon the approval of the Administration. Sales of class rings, school pictures and similar items will be

permitted with price quotations to be taken at least every three (3) years. Input shall be received by the Administration from involved student and parent organizations.
