## **TCHD COVID High School Vaccine Clinic**

The Tazewell County Health Department is offering 2 Pfizer vaccine clinic dates for high school students. The Pfizer vaccine is a two-dose vaccine available to persons 16 years or older. Second doses will be given 21 days after the 1<sup>st</sup> dose.

Monday, April 26<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 am - 3:45 pm -  $2^{nd}$  dose May 17<sup>th</sup> Monday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> from 8:30 am - 3:45 pm -  $2^{nd}$  dose May 24<sup>th</sup>

At: TCHD Broadway Location, 1800 Broadway Road, Pekin

You must live and/or work in Peoria, Tazewell and Woodford Counties to attend this clinic. Individuals who are minors (age 16 & 17) MUST be accompanied by an adult (18+). If a parent/guardian is not able to attend the appointment, a signed written consent from a parent/guardian must be provided.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- 16 & 17 year olds can receive the Pfizer vaccine only it is FDA approved for use in that age range.
- A parent/legal guardian MUST provide signed written consent.
- An adult (18+) MUST accompany the minor to the appointment.
- Please make sure to wear appropriate clothing to receive a vaccine.
- If you have questions about the vaccine, please reach out to your medical provider prior to scheduling your appointment.
- Schedule your vaccination 14 days after receiving any other vaccination.
- Schedule your vaccination at least 90 days after receiving any monoclonal antibodies (BAM IV infusion) or convalescent plasma as part of treatment for COVID-19.
