Pfizer COVID Vaccine Drive-Thru Clinic

The Tazewell County Health Department is offering a drive-thru vaccine clinic every Thursday through Sunday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Pfizer offers a two-dose vaccine that is available to those age 16 or older. Second doses will be given 21 days after the first dose.

Date: Every Thursday–Sunday, beginning on 4/22/21

Location: Tazewell County Health Department, 21306 Illinois Route 9, Tremont

You must live and/or work in Peoria, Tazewell or Woodford Counties to attend this clinic. Minors – those age 16 and 17 – **must** be accompanied by a legal guardian to complete the consent on site.

No appointment or registration is required.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- You must bring a valid state ID and provide a phone number.
- Please make sure to wear appropriate clothing to receive the vaccine.
- Sixteen- and 17-year-olds can receive the Pfizer vaccine **only**, as it is FDA-approved for use in that age range.
- A legal guardian **must** accompany the minor to the appointment to sign the consent on site.
- If you have questions about the vaccine, please reach out to your medical provider prior to scheduling your appointment.
- You can receive your COVID vaccination 14 days after receiving any other vaccination.
- You can receive your COVID vaccination at least 90 days after receiving any monoclonal antibodies (BAM IV infusion) or convalescent plasma as part of a treatment for COVID-19.
