

April 30, 2021 Free meal program to continue this summer

Morton School District 709, in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, is continuing its free meal program through the summer months.

All Morton children ages 1 to 18 – not just District 709 students -- are eligible for the program, regardless of family income. Families who wish to participate can sign up for the meals <u>here</u> between May 1 and May 14.

The dates for summer pick-up are May 24, May 31, June 7, June 14, June 21 and



June 28 – Mondays all. The five days' worth of meals are available between 10:30 a.m. and 11 a.m. at the Bertha Frank Performing Arts Center at Morton High School, 350 N. Illinois Ave.

This USDA program is a carryover from the free lunch program instituted in 2020 in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic.
