**Reorganization of the Board of Education—** The Board of Education re-elected Mr. Braker—President; Dr. Cross—Vice-President; Mr. Rinkenberger— Secretary for the 2022-23 School Year.

**Audience Presentation:** Dr. Shawn Durbin shared his perspective on recent interactions with school personnel as well as some previous communications.

### **Administrative Reports—**

- ◆ Superintendent's Report—Dr. Hill:
  - ⇒ reported on the district's application to the DoIT Consortium to be considered for an internet upgrade that would pay for and provide a superior internet supplier.
  - ⇒ reported the district has received 3.8 million dollars over the past year from CPPRT. In previous years, the revenue was 1.2 and 1.8 million dollars.
